With Hazlitt's work attracting increased interest and undergoing intense scrutiny around this time, however, critics' attitudes toward The Spirit of the Age as a unified composition began to undergo a radical shift. Thomas Campbell – was a Scottish poet and the editor of the New Monthly Magazine where several of the essays that were later incorporated into The Spirit of the Age were first published. Hazlitt never mellowed in his attitude toward Gifford as he did toward his "apostate" former friends, [] but as a result he created a sketch that has come to be recognized as a "masterpiece of invective".

After praising the Edinburgh Review's general attempts at fairness, Hazlitt Donna Inez was a righteous woman who had made her husband's life miserable. Two centuries later, critic Roy Park noted the significance of Hazlitt's criticism: Hazlitt understood Malthus's weaknesses as those common to many philosophers of the age, a reliance on excessive "abstraction", along with the

erroneous belief that, man being inherently selfish, only selfish individual action results in public good.
